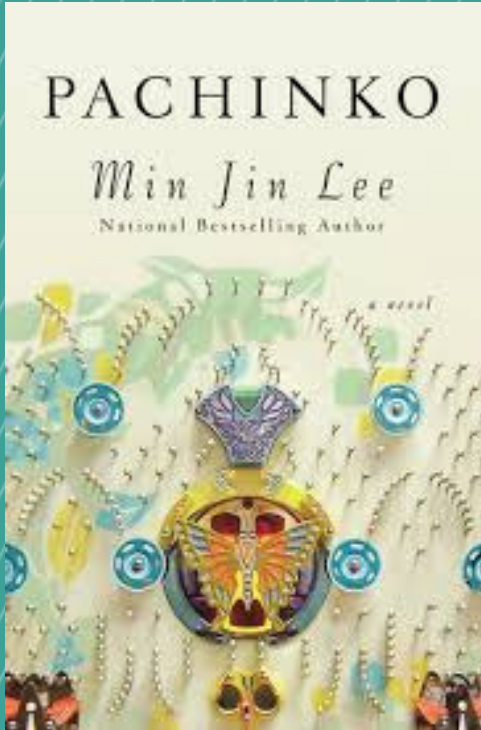


# AN EVENING CONVERSATION WITH BESTSELLING AUTHOR MIN JIN LEE OF THE NOVEL "PACHINKO"
