
LOCAL AUTHOR TALK WITH BONNI BRODNICK


My Stroke in the Fast Lane: A Journey to Recovery begins on Easter Sunday morning. While driving home at 65 mph on an interstate highway, Bonni had a stroke. Her 86-year-old mother, sitting in the passenger seat, grabbed the wheel and crashed them into a guardrail. 
